

## COVID-19 STAY SAFE PLEDGE

1. **DO NOT** come to school if you or someone in your household are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19:
  - a. a new, continuous cough
  - b. a high temperature (above 37.8)
  - c. a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or tasteIf you are experiencing any of these symptoms, you **MUST** stay at home, get a COVID-19 test and stay at home for 10 days unless you receive a negative test result. All members of your household will also have to isolate for 14 days (or until a negative test result).
2. **Follow instructions straight away and accept sanctions without argument.**
3. Alert a member of staff immediately if you feel you have any Covid-19 symptoms.
4. Stay in your bubble. Avoid contact with students in other bubbles.
5. Keep 1 metre+ distance from ALL staff at ALL times.
6. Keep some distance from other students, even those in your bubble. No physical contact of any kind.
7. Wash your hands more often with soap and water for 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer.
8. Catch it, Bin it, Kill it! Cough and sneeze into a tissue (or your elbow).
9. NEVER cough, sneeze or spit at/towards any other person.
10. Try not to touch your face, especially your mouth, nose and eyes.
11. Wear a lanyard at all times so that it is visible to all staff and students - except practical PE lessons.
12. Only use your designated entrance and exits to the school site at your designated times.
13. Stay in your allocated classrooms unless directed otherwise.
14. Stay at your own desk unless directed otherwise.
15. Do not ask to leave class to use the toilet unless it is an emergency. A staff member will have to escort you to the toilet during lesson time.
16. When using the toilet at break and lunch - maintain some distance from all other students.
17. Only use your own books, resources and equipment, not interfering or touching any others books, resources or equipment.
18. Only use your own water bottles and eat/drink your own food.
19. Work with school staff to ensure that any re-usable equipment is sanitised after each use

We will investigate to distinguish between accidental and purposeful rule-breaking by students. Deliberate breaking of the rules that jeopardises the safety of others will be seen as a Serious Breach of the Code of Conduct.

On the rare occasion that a student fails to follow the expectations in our 'COVID-19 Stay Safe Pledge', the sanction system will be applied. If the student fails to correct their behaviour or their behaviour is deemed so serious that they cannot safely stay in school, the student will be deemed to pose a serious risk to the Health and Safety of students and staff. Parents will be contacted, the student will be formally excluded and will need to be collected from school to ensure the safety of themselves and others.
