

Are you thinking of applying for an apprenticeship?

- Most major organisations start to open their apprenticeship vacancies from now for start dates July – Sept 2019
- Vacancies are usually advertised until they are filled – DO NOT WAIT TO APPLY IF YOU ARE INTERESTED
- You can apply to University and apply for as many apprenticeships as you want at the same time
- Do not rely on one source of information to let you know where all the vacancies are
- Ask for help

Useful sources of information on latest apprenticeship vacancies – NB: No one site has ALL vacancies – check as many sources as possible


- Young Professionals UK App – download from the app store – useful app for vacancies, internships and work experience in top UK companies
